Arborvite damage in just one year!



Half of the arborvite hedgerow pictured above was attacked and killed by the bagworm seemingly overnight. Left untreated the rest would have followed suit. Since it is impossible to replace 8 foot tall bushes the owners only choices are the following:

- a. Remove the entire hedge row or
- b. Replace the dead bushes with smaller plants which will hurt the integrity of the row.

The bagworm will attack a large variety of trees and shrubs including, but not limited to spruce, cedars, junipers, and deciduous trees such as maples.

Spruce trees are beautiful and take a long time to grow. The damage pictured below occurred in just one months time.

This tree is damaged beyond the point of recovery and needed to be removed. Unfortunately, this was the middle tree in a group of three. Tree Green saved the remaining two but an unwanted vacancy was left behind.
