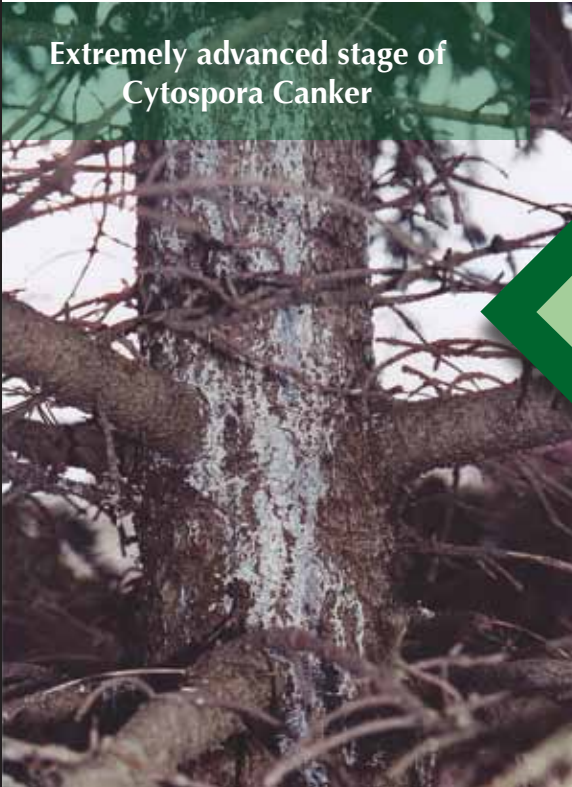


Cytospora Canker of Spruce

CYTOSPORA CANKER

Extremely advanced stage of Cytospora Canker



Cytospora Canker is a fungal disease that attacks all varieties of Spruce trees. The fungal spores associated with the disease are spread by wind, rain, pruning tools, even the feet of birds. In its early stage the fungus appears as white, grey or blue-grey spots or streaks on the trunk and/or limbs as shown in the photo. Cytospora attacks weak trees and trees over 15 years old. Once attached to the tree the canker kills in a variety of ways; limb by limb anywhere within the tree, or from the top down.

TREATMENT . . .

Unfortunately there is no known product that eliminates Cytospora Canker, either through sprays or trunk injections. As we stated, the canker attacks weakening spruce over 15 years old.
